Incorporated for approval of an interconnection agreement between US West Communications,
Incorporated and Dieca Communications,
Incorporated, doing business as Covad
Communications Company. Today shall the Commission approve the interconnection agreement.

Are you going to start with that one again?

MR. SENGER: No. I think Camron's taking that.

MS. HOSECK: Mr. Chairman, members of the Commission, on February 25 I filed my staff recommendation and analysis in this matter. The recommendation was not to approve it until two conditions were met, one of which was Covad had a CLA, which we have just taken care of. The second one is the agreement be subject to South Dakota Law.

And a miracle occurred this morning and the language appeared and I'm satisfied with the language that they have submitted as a submission. And it will be substituted in the contract. With that, I would recommend approval of the interconnection agreement.
