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On August 13, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint by Greg and Karen Muellerleile dba Dakota Woodworking, Watertown, South Dakota (Complainants), against U.S. Republic Communications, Inc. (U.S. Republic) regarding unauthorized switching of services. The Complainants are requesting U.S. Republic "to reimburse charges assessed to our telephone without authorization and pay \$1000 for the violation."

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On September 8, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff informed the Commission that the parties had reached a settlement and the Complainants wished to have the complaint dismissed and the docket closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-13-1, 49-13-4, 49-13-13, 49-13-14.1, 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-11, 49-31-89 through 49-31-96, inclusive, and ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that this complaint be dismissed and the docket be closed.
