On December 20, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Jerry Ogan on behalf of Ogan Construction, Blunt, South Dakota (Complainant), against Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) regarding unauthorized switching of services. The Complainant asked for imposition of appropriate statutory remedies. The Complaint was amended to include Crusade Communications.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. Probable cause was found against Sprint on January 6, 2000, and against Crusade Communications on January 18, 2000.

On March 16, 2000, the Commission Staff received a copy of a transmission to Complainant indicating that there had been a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed and further on that date Complainant met with Commission Staff indicating resolution of the complaint.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13 and 49-31.

On March 28, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
