On December 15, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Keith Enstad, Watertown, South Dakota (Complainant), against OLS, Inc. (OLS) regarding alleged switching telecommunications services through deceptive tactics. Complainant requests full credit of all OLS charges.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On December 28, 1999, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff recommended a finding of probable cause due to unresolved factual issues.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-38, 49-31-38, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34. The Commission voted unanimously to find probable cause. It is therefore

ORDERED, that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the Commission finds that there is probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and that the complaint shall be forwarded to OLS and OLS shall satisfy the complaint or file with the Commission its answer in writing within twenty (20) days of service of this order.
