On March 15, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Bonnie Struss, Watertown, South Dakota (Complainant), against HOLD Billing Services. By letter dated March 20, 2000, Complainant asked that Business Options, Inc. be added to her complaint. The Complainant alleges that her long distance service was switched without her authorization. The Complainant requested compensation.

On May 30, 2000, the Commission Staff received a letter from Complainant indicating that there had been a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, and 49-31.

On May 30, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
