On May 15, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Leon L. Lengkeek, Brookings, South Dakota (Complainant), against Crusade Communications (Crusade) and Business Options, Inc. (Business Options) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

On May 17, 2000, the complaint was faxed to Crusade and Business Options. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the companies were notified that they must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by June 6, 2000. The Commission has not received an answer from Crusade or Business Options to this complaint. A hearing in this matter was scheduled for July 6, 2000. By order dated July 5, 2000, the hearing was cancelled as Commission Staff received word from the Complainant stating that the complaint against Crusade and Business Options had been resolved.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On July 20, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
