The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

By order dated August 2, 2000, a hearing was scheduled for August 22, 2000, in Room 412 of the State Capitol Building, 500 E. Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota, immediately following the hearing for Docket CT00-072, which is scheduled to begin at 8:30 o'clock A.M. On August 18, 2000, Commission Staff was informed that settlement had been reached in this matter, so therefore the hearing is cancelled. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the hearing scheduled for August 22, 2000, is cancelled.
