On July 24, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Ed and Janice St. Gemme, Dakota Dunes, South Dakota (Complainants), against AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

On July 25, 2000, the complaint was faxed to AT&T. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the company was notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by August 14, 2000. On August 14, 2000, AT&T filed an Answer and Motion to Dismiss and Motion to Join Local Exchange Carrier Qwest Corporation (Qwest), formerly known as U S WEST Communications, Inc. as a party

At its regularly scheduled meeting of September 13, 2000, the Commission considered the Motion to Join Local Exchange Carrier Qwest as a party. Qwest stated that it objected to being added as a party. The Commission voted to grant AT&T's Motion to Join Local Exchange Carrier Qwest Corporation as a party. On October 10, 2000, Qwest filed an Answer to Complaint and Motion to Dismiss.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-12 through 49-31-12.5, inclusive, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-84 through 49-31-86.2, inclusive.

On October 17, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered the Motions to Dismiss. The Commission voted unanimously to deny the Motions to Dismiss of AT&T and Qwest. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Motions to Dismiss of AT&T and Qwest are hereby denied.
