On October 19, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Shirley J. Noble, Rapid City, South Dakota (Complainant), against Preferred Billing (Preferred). The Complainant alleged that her long distance provider was switched without her authorization and she asked for appropriate statutory remedies.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint. Probable cause was determined at the Commission's regularly scheduled November 1, 1999, meeting. A hearing was to be held on January 26, 2000, but was cancelled.

The Commission Staff received a letter from Complainant indicating that there had been a resolution of the matter and that the case should be considered closed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13 and 49-31.

On February 2, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
