On December 30, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint from Robert Fogg, Jr., Martin, South Dakota (Complainant), against AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. (AT&T) regarding his eligibility for various billing plans and the rates at which he was billed for long distance service by AT&T.

On January 18, 2000, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Complainant appeared via teleconference. Commission Staff recommended that no finding of probable cause be made.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, and 49-31.

The Commission voted unanimously to find no probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission on the part of AT&T and to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint is dismissed and Docket CT00-007 is hereby closed.
