## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA

IN THE MATTER OF THE COMPLAINT FILED BY ELIZABETH A. EWALD, WATERTOWN, SOUTH DAKOTA, AGAINST OLS, INC. REGARDING SWITCHING OF SERVICES THROUGH DECEPTIVE PRACTICES

ORDER FINDING PROBABLE CAUSE AND NOTICE REQUIRING ANSWER CT00-009

On January 3, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Elizabeth A. Ewald, Watertown, South Dakota (Complainant), against OLS, Inc. (OLS) regarding switching of services through deceptive practices. Complainant requests that fines and penalties be assessed against OLS for this action.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On February 2, 2000, at a duly noticed meeting, Commission Staff recommended a finding of probable cause due to unresolved factual issues.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-7, 49-31-38, 49-31, 49-31-38, 49-31, 49

ORDERED, that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the Commission finds that there is probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and that the complaint shall be forwarded to OLS and OLS shall satisfy the complaint or file with the Commission its answer in writing within twenty (20) days of service of this order.
