On April 20, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Tim and Kay Trooien, White, South Dakota, (Complainants), against HBS Billing Services and Business Options, Inc. regarding unauthorized switching of services and unauthorized billing for services. The Complainants allege they received a phone bill in March, 2000, with long distance charges from HBS Billing Services from December 1, 1999, to January 15, 2000. The Complainants did not recognize HBS Billing Services and report that neither authorized a change in telephone service. The Complainants request that HBS Billing Services be penalized to the full extent of the law for the unlawful change in long distance services. The Complainants request that the PUC force HBS Billing Services to fully reimburse them with a billing refund and the \$1000.00 compensation.

On April 20, 2000, the complaint was faxed to HBS Billing Services and Business Options, Inc. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, HBS Billing Services and Business Options, Inc. were notified that it must satisfy the complaint or file an answer in writing with the Commission by May 11, 2000. Commission Staff received word from the Complainants stating that the complaint against HBS Billing Services and Business Options, Inc. had been resolved.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.

On July 20, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the complaint shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
