## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA

ORDER FINDING
PROBABLE CAUSE AND
NOTICE REQUIRING
ANSWER

On December 28, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Dan Grider, Baltic, South Dakota (Complainant), against Qwest Communications Inc. (Qwest). The Complainant alleges his long distance provider was switched to Qwest without his authorization. Complainant requests reinstatement to his previous provider and the imposition of statutory fines and penalties.

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:08.01 and 20:10:01:09, if a complaint cannot be settled without formal action, the Commission shall determine if the complaint shows probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission to go forward with the complaint.

On January 18, 2000, at a duly noticed meeting, the Complainant appeared and the Commission considered this matter and determined that there was probable cause that an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice or omission was committed by Qwest. Qwest did not appear. Commission Staff recommended a finding of probable cause.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13 and 49-31. The Commission voted unanimously to find probable cause. It is therefore

ORDERED, that pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, the Commission finds that there is probable cause of an unlawful or unreasonable act, rate, practice, or omission and the complaint shall be forwarded to Qwest and Qwest shall satisfy the complaint or file with the Commission its answer in writing within twenty (20) days of service of this order.
