On May 7, 2001, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Judy C. Foster, Sioux Falls, South Dakota (Complainant), against WebNet Communications, Inc. (WebNet) and ILD Teleservices, Inc. (ILD) regarding unauthorized switching of services.

On May 7, 2001, the complaint was faxed to WebNet and ILD. Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:09, WebNet and ILD were notified that they must satisfy the complaint or file answers in writing with the Commission by May 28, 2001. On May 25, 2001, the Commission received a letter response from ILD. WebNet contacted Commission Staff requesting an extension of time to file its answer until June 4, 2001, which Commission Staff granted. A hearing in this matter was scheduled for June 20, 2001. On June 4, 2001, the Commission received a Motion to Dismiss from WebNet. By order dated June 15, 2001, the hearing was cancelled as Commission Staff was informed that the complainant had withdrawn her complaint.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-7.3, 49-31-7.4, 49-31-10, 49-31-11, 49-31-38, 49-31-38.1, 49-31-38.2, 49-31-38.3, 49-31-89 through 49-31-97, inclusive, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:34.


