On April 14, 2008, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by Roger L. Hall, Rapid City, South Dakota (Complainant) against Qwest Corporation regarding the cost of telephone line extensions.

On April 17, 2008, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities. On May 5, 2008, the Commission received Qwest Corporation's Answer and Motion to Dismiss. On June 24, 2008, the Commission received Roger L. Hall's Response to Qwest Corporation's Motion to Dismiss.

The parties have agreed to the following procedural schedule

January 27, 2009	Pre-Hearing motions will be heard

A hearing in this matter will be scheduled sometime during the month of March 2009.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-1, including 49-1-9 and 49-1-11, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14.1, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-11, 49-31-76 and 49-31-89, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:32. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the parties shall follow the procedural schedule as set forth above.
