**ORDER DISMISSING
COMPLAINT AND

On December 19, 2011, Lee Anderson with Progressive Property Management filed a Complaint regarding a billing dispute against MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission). On December 19, 2012, the Commission served a Notice of Complaint; Deadline for Answer on MidAmerican. On January 9, 2012, MidAmerican filed a detailed Answer to the Complaint.


The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49- 34A, including 49-34A-3,49-34A-4, and 49-34A-6, and ARSD Chapter 20:10:01, including 20:10:01:07:01 through 20:10:01:11:01, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:15 through 20:10:17.

A hearing on the dispute was scheduled for April 13, 2012. Prior to the scheduled April 13 hearing, the parties notified the Commission of a pending settlement and requested that the hearing be cancelled. Since that time, the Commission received confirmation of settlement.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of April 24, 2012, the Commission considered whether to dismiss this Complaint. Commission Staff recommended dismissal as all pending issues are resolved. The Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the complaint and to close the docket. It is therefore


ORDERED, that the complaint is hereby dismissed and the docket is closed.
