On May 9, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received Northern States Power Company's (NSP) 1999 Economic Development Annual Report and proposed Economic Development Plan for 2000. The proposed plan was filed in accordance with the settlement agreements reached between NSP and Commission Staff, and approved by the Commission, in the company's most recent rate case filings, Dockets EL91-004 and EL92-016.

For 2000, NSP's proposed economic development investment budget is \$102,020. The actual expenditures for the 1999 Economic Development Plan were \$118,500. Fifty percent of the 2000 budget would be recovered through rates, with the remaining 50% funded by shareholders.

At its regularly scheduled June 20, 2000, meeting, the Commission reviewed NSP's 1999 Economic Development Annual Report and Economic Development Plan for 2000. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, SDCL 49-34A-4 and 49-34A-6. After review of the report and plan, the Commission found that they are just and reasonable and voted to approve them. It is therefore

ORDERED, that NSP's 1999 Economic Development Annual Report and Economic Development Plan for 2000 are approved as filed.
