On January 5, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) requesting approval of its electric tariff sheet changes. According to the filing, MidAmerican proposes to revise its bill display. Specific line items will be more descriptive and the late payment charge message has been reworded for better understanding. On January 17, 2007, the Commission received revised tariff sheets from MidAmerican. The revised tariff sheets are as follows:

SDPUC Electric Tariff No. 1  
Section No. 6

7th Revised Sheet No. 1  
10th Revised Sheet No. 2

Canceling 6th Revised Sheet No. 1  
Canceling 9th Revised Sheet No. 2

At its regularly scheduled meeting of February 13, 2007, the Commission discussed final approval of the application. Commission Staff recommended approval of the bill format tariff sheets.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-2, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, and 49-34A-10 and ARSD 20:10:17:03. The Commission finds the bill format changes to the customers' bills are just and reasonable and approves the changes. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced revised tariffs are approved and are effective February 13, 2007.
