IN THE MATTER OF THE FILING BY ORDER GRANTING MIDAMERICAN ENERGY COMPANY FOR WITHDRAWAL OF FILING APPROVAL OF ITS GENERATION AND CLOSING DOCKET INTERCONNECTION PROCEDURES EL07-028

On September 24, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) for approval of its current interconnection procedures applicable to state jurisdictional interconnections, pursuant to a Commission Order in Docket EL06-018. MidAmerican stated that the procedures vary based on the size of the interconnected generator and also based on whether the interconnected generator intends to export power to MidAmerican.

On August 5, 2009, MidAmerican requested that its filing be withdrawn due to the interconnection rules recently approved by the Commission.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 11, 2009, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. The Commission found that MidAmerican's request to withdraw its filing is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican shall be permitted to withdraw its filing, and it is further

ORDERED, that this docket is closed.
