On September 24, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Black Hills Power, Inc. (BHP) for approval of its interconnection procedures for distribution generation facilities. The proposed tariff pages include an application for interconnection, procedures for interconnection, and an interconnection agreement.

On August 4, 2009, BHP requested that its filing be withdrawn due to the interconnection rules recently approved by the Commission.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 11, 2009, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. The Commission found that BHP's request to withdraw its filing is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that BHP shall be permitted to withdraw its filing, and it is further

ORDERED, that this docket is closed.
