ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF FILING AND CLOSING DOCKET EL07-031

On October 9, 2007, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Otter Tail Power Company (OTP) for approval of its interconnection procedures for distribution generation facilities, pursuant to a Commission Order in Docket EL06-018. The proposed tariff pages included an application for interconnection, procedures for interconnection, and an interconnection agreement.

On July 23, 2009, OTP requested that its filing be withdrawn due to the interconnection rules recently approved by the Commission.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of August 11, 2009, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A. The Commission found that OTP's request to withdraw its filing is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that OTP shall be permitted to withdraw its filing, and it is further

ORDERED, that this docket is closed.
