On June 29, 2010, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by NorthWestern Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) to update the payment schedule for energy; introduce a payment for capacity per KW; and update the terms and conditions in the Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Occasional delivery energy service), Rate No. 73, and the Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Time of delivery energy service), Rate No. 74. NorthWestern has requested an effective date of September 1, 2010, for the proposed modifications to the rate schedules. The revised tariff sheets are as follows:

The Commission finds that is has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-12.

At its August 25, 2010, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff recommended approval to revise NorthWestern's Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Occasional delivery energy service), Rate No. 73, and the Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Time of delivery energy service), Rate No. 74. The Commission finds the revisions are just and reasonable and approves the revisions. It is therefore

ORDERED, that NorthWestern's request to update the payment schedule for energy; introduce a payment for capacity per KW; and update the terms and conditions in the Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Occasional delivery energy service), Rate No. 73, and the Small Qualifying Facility Rider (Time of delivery energy service), Rate No. 74 is hereby granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that the above-mentioned tariffs are approved and are effective for services rendered on and after September 1, 2010.
