On February 1, 2012, the Commission received an electric service territory boundary agreement between LaCreek Electric Association, Inc. and Black Hills Electric Cooperative, Inc. This filling was submitted by Commission Staff pursuant to current efforts of the PUC to verify electric territory mapping data for conversion to electronic format and use in a Geographic Information System (GIS) database.

On February 2, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 17, 2012, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on February 28, 2012, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff requested approval of the agreement in order to update official electric service territory mapping data to accurately reflect current service territories served by the utilities. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the agreement.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over the matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-42, 49-34A-43 and 49-34A-55. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the request seeking approval of the agreement verifying current electric service territory boundary shared by LaCreek Electric Association, Inc. and Black Hills Electric Cooperative Inc. is hereby granted.
