**ORDER SUSPENDING  
OPERATION OF  
RATE SCHEDULE**

**EL17-006**

On February 15, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (BHE) for Approval of its 2017 Transmission Facilities Adjustment (TFA). BHE seeks approval of the annual true-up of the actual amounts collected in the third year of the TFA, as approved in Docket EL16-005, and the forecasted recovery of revenue requirements associated with the fourth year of the TFA. BHE proposes TFA rates effective June 1, 2017, through May 31, 2018. Approximately 68,000 South Dakota customers will be affected by the TFA rate change. The bill increase for a typical residential customer averaging 650 kWh per month will be approximately 0.02 percent.

On February 16, 2017, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of March 3, 2017, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. As of the date of this order, no petitions to intervene or comments had been filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, particularly 49-34A-14 and 49-34A-25.1 through 49-34A-25.4. SDCL 49-34A-14 authorizes the Commission to suspend the operation of proposed rates for one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date on which the proposed rates were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on March 28, 2017, the Commission considered this matter. Commission Staff requested that the Commission suspend the imposition of the rates pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-14. The Commission voted unanimously to suspend the operation of the schedule of rates proposed by BHE for 180 days beyond February 15, 2017. It is therefore

**ORDERED**, that the proposed schedule of rates shall be suspended for a period not to exceed 180 days beyond February 15, 2017, pursuant to SDCL 49-34A-14.
