**ORDER GRANTING
APPROVAL OF ELECTRIC
SERVICE TERRITORY
BOUNDARY CHANGE**

On November 29, 2018, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Memorandum of Understanding between Clay-Union Electric Corporation and the City of Vermillion regarding a non-annexation boundary change to the agreement in Docket EL14-015. Clay-Union Electric Corporation and the City of Vermillion agree to revise maps and documentation that place Lots 5 and 6, Block 2, Lotuswood Addition in the Clay-Union Electric Corporation service territory.

On December 6, 2018, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 21, 2018, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On February 13, 2019, the accompanying legal description and maps pertaining to Lots 5 and 6, Block 2, Lotuswood Addition were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-42, 49-34A-43, and 49-34A-55.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on March 1, 2019, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the boundary change in order to update the official electric service territory mapping data to accurately reflect the current service territories served by the utilities. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the request for a territory boundary change to accurately reflect the current service territories served by the utilities. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the request for approval of the above-described change to the assigned territory boundary between Clay-Union Electric Corporation and the City of Vermillion is hereby granted.
