On March 6, 2019, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application to construct the Sweetland Wind Farm, LLC (Sweetland), a wind energy facility located on approximately 20,979 acres of land in Hand County, South Dakota, in the townships of Pearl, Hulbert, and Rose Hill, South Dakota, and a 230-kV transmission line (Project). The total installed capacity of the Project would be approximately 200 MW nameplate capacity. The proposed Project includes up to 71 wind turbine generators, access roads to turbines and associated facilities, underground electrical power collector lines connecting the turbines to the Project substation, an operations and maintenance facility, and temporary construction areas, including crane paths, pull sites, access roads, a laydown yard, and a concrete batch plant(s) (as needed), and four permanent meteorological towers. The Project would interconnect to the regional electric grid along the Western Area Power Administration's existing Fort Thompson to Huron transmission line via a new switchyard located in Rose Hill Township. The Project will result in the installation of approximately 7 miles of 230-kV overhead transmission line. The Applicant does not currently have a purchase agreement for the Project but is currently in discussions with interested parties.

On March 7, 2019, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 6, 2019, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. A public input meeting to take public comments regarding the Project was held on April 25, 2019, in Miller, South Dakota. On May 2, 2019, staff filed a Motion for Adoption for Procedural Schedule. On May 6, 2019, Theresa Lichy filed an application for party status. On May 14, 2019, party status was been granted to one individual, Theresa Lichy. On June 26, 2019, Applicant filed a Settlement Stipulation and Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation between Applicant and Theresa Lichy.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-41B, specifically, 1-26-20, and ARSD 20:10:01:19.

The Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation was noticed for Commission consideration and action at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 9, 2019. The Commission heard from Sweetland and staff concerning the Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation and the related Settlement Stipulation. Staff did not take a position on the Settlement Stipulation. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket and after making further inquiry of the parties, the Commission found that the terms and conditions proposed in the Settlement Stipulation were just, reasonable, and in the public interest, and that good and sufficient cause was demonstrated to approve the Settlement Stipulation. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the Joint

Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation and approve the Settlement Stipulation and to grant withdrawal of party status to Theresa Lichty. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation is hereby granted, and the Settlement Stipulation is hereby approved. The Settlement Stipulation is incorporated by reference into this Order the same as if it had been set forth in its entirety herein. It is further

ORDERED, that withdrawal of party status is hereby granted to Theresa Lichty.
