**ORDER GRANTING JOINT
MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF
SECOND AMENDMENT TO
SETTLEMENT STIPULATION**

On February 15, 2017, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application by Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (BHE) for Approval of its 2017 Transmission Facilities Adjustment (TFA). On June 9, 2017, BHE and Commission staff (staff) filed a Settlement Stipulation and Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation. The Commission issued an Order Granting Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation on June 20, 2017. On May 1, 2018, BHE and staff filed an Amendment to Settlement Stipulation and Joint Motion for Approval of Amendment to Settlement Stipulation. The Commission issued an Order Granting Joint Motion for Approval of Amendment to Settlement Stipulation on May 16, 2018. On December 31, 2019, BHE and staff filed a Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation and Joint Motion for Approval of Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation. Staff also filed a staff Memorandum Supporting Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation on December 31, 2019.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-6, 49-34A-8, 49-34A-8.4, and 49-34A-11, and ARSD 20:10:01:19.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on January 7, 2020, the Commission considered this matter. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket, the Commission found that the terms and conditions proposed in the Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation were just, reasonable, and in the public interest and that good and sufficient cause was demonstrated to approve the Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the Joint Motion for Approval of Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Joint Motion for Approval of Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation is granted. The Second Amendment to Settlement Stipulation is incorporated by reference into this Order the same as if it had been set forth in its entirety herein.
