On February 12, 2020, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received MidAmerican Energy Company's (MidAmerican) filing for determination of its energy cost adjustment factor as applied to repowered wind facilities. MidAmerican is currently in the process of repowering up to 510 existing wind turbines, which will qualify for new production tax credits (PTCs) under guidance from the Internal Revenue Service. With this filing, MidAmerican requests a ruling identifying that the new PTCs will not be subject to the provisions of MidAmerican's energy cost adjustment (ECA) tariff.

On February 13, 2020, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 28, 2020, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On May 18, 2020, MidAmerican responded to Commission staff's data requests.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically 49-34A-4, 49-34A-10, and 49-34A-25.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 26, 2020, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the determination that the new PTCs resulting from the repowering of up to 510 existing wind turbines are not subject to the provisions of MidAmerican's ECA tariff, subject to the condition that such approval shall not preclude Commission review of the project, including project and cost management and accounting data and methods, review of the prudence and reasonableness of rate recovery in any determination of rates (including rate filings by MidAmerican or rate reviews initiated by the Commission), and that it does not guarantee any such rate recovery. Finding the determination to be just and reasonable, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the determination with the conditions as outlined by Commission staff. It is therefore

ORDERED, that MidAmerican's request for a determination that the new PTCs resulting from the repowering of up to 510 existing wind turbines are not subject to the provisions of MidAmerican's ECA tariff is hereby approved, subject to the condition that such approval shall not preclude Commission review of the project, including project and cost management and accounting data and methods, review of the prudence and reasonableness of rate recovery in any determination of rates (including rate filings by MidAmerican or rate reviews initiated by the Commission), and that it does not guarantee any such rate recovery.
