On November 29, 2012, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued and served on all parties an Order for and Notice of Hearing (Notice of Hearing) setting for hearing the request for hearing filed by Ray Martinmaas on behalf of Martinmaas Dairy Inc. (Martinmaas) to contest Commission Staff's determination and recommendation that the Martinmaas claim is based on a voluntary credit sale and is therefore barred from coverage pursuant to SDCL 49-45-9. The Notice of Hearing set the matter for hearing commencing at 1:30 p.m., with marking of exhibits to begin at 1:15 p.m., on Tuesday, December 18, 2012, in Room 413, State Capitol Building, 500 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota. Due to a scheduling conflict that has developed with Room 413 of the State Capital Building, the location of the hearing has been moved to Room 412 of the State Capital Building.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Receivership Order and SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-45, specifically 49-45-1.1 (5), 49-45-6, 49-45-9, 49-45-11, and 49-45-16.1, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:12. It is therefore

ORDERED, that a hearing shall be held on the issues set forth in the Notice of Hearing commencing at 1:30 p.m., with marking of exhibits to begin at 1:15 p.m., on Tuesday, December 18, 2012, in Room 412, State Capitol Building, 500 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota. Except for the change of hearing room, all other notices and matters set forth in the Notice of Hearing shall remain in effect.
