ORDER GRANTING
REQUEST TO WITHDRAW
PARTY STATUS

On September 15, 2014, TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, LP (Keystone) filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a Petition for Order Accepting Certification under SDCL §49-41B-27 (Petition) seeking an order accepting certification of the energy facility permit issued in Docket HP09-001 for construction of the Keystone XL Pipeline (Project). On June 29, 2010, the Commission issued an Amended Final Decision and Order; Notice of Entry (Decision) granting a permit to Keystone for construction of the Keystone XL Pipeline. Because it has been more than four years since the permit was issued and construction has not commenced, Keystone now seeks an order accepting certification pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-27. On November 4, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Granting Intervention and Party Status granting intervention to forty-two intervenors. On April 7, 2015, Jeff Jensen filed a letter requesting withdrawal of his party status.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-41B.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 14, 2015, the Commission considered the request to withdraw party status. The Commission voted unanimously to allow Jeff Jensen to withdraw.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that the request of Jeff Jensen to withdraw as a party to this docket is hereby granted.
