On March 23, 2018, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from NorthWestern Corporation dba NorthWestern Energy (NorthWestern) requesting approval of its 2018 Economic Development Proposed Budget and 2017 Economic Development Report.

On March 29, 2018, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of April 13, 2018, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed. On April 6, 2018, NorthWestern responded to Staff's data request.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A, specifically, SDCL 49-34A-4 and 49-34A-6.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 20, 2018, the Commission considered this matter. After review of the report and plan, the Commission found the activities and contributions set forth therein to be just and reasonable and voted unanimously to approve NorthWestern's 2017 Economic Development Report and the 2018 Economic Development Budget. It is therefore

ORDERED, that NorthWestern's 2017 Economic Development Report and 2018 Economic Development Budget are approved as filed.
