On April 15, 1997, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, received an application for a certificate of authority from One Step Billing, Inc. (One Step).

One Step plans to offer a full range of 1+ interexchange telecommunications services on a resale basis. Specifically, One Step plans to provide MTS, out-WATS, in-WATS, and calling card services. One Step does not plan to provide operator services, 900 or 700 services. A proposed tariff was filed by One Step. The Commission has classified long distance service as fully competitive.

On April 17, 1997, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 2, 1997, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and at its regularly scheduled June 24, 1997, meeting, the Commission considered One Step's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02 and 20:10:24:03. The Commission finds that One Step has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. One Step has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. The Commission approves One Step's application for a certificate of authority. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that One Step's application for a certificate of authority is hereby granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that One Step shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur.
