On November 30, 1998, New Millennium ConQuest Service Corporation (NM ConQuest) filed an application with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for a certificate of authority to operate as a telecommunications company within the state of South Dakota. On May 6, 1999, NM ConQuest requested that its application for a certificate of authority be withdrawn.

At its regularly scheduled May 12, 1999, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD Chapter 20:10:24. The Commission found that NM ConQuest's request to withdraw its request for a certificate of authority is reasonable and closed the docket. It is therefore
