On February 19, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission), in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02, received an application for a certificate of authority from GCC License Corporation (GCC).

An amended application for a certificate of authority was received on March 19, 1999. GCC seeks authority to provide resold intrastate interexchange telecommunications services statewide, including presubscription long distance, calling card, prepaid calling card, 10XXX and "personalized 800 service." A proposed tariff was filed by GCC. The Commission has classified long distance service as fully competitive.

On February 25, 1999, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of March 12, 1999, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed and a June 22, 1999, meeting, the Commission considered GCC's request for a certificate of authority. Commission Staff recommended granting a certificate of authority, subject to GCC furnishing the Commission with a corrected surety bond.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-3 and ARSD 20:10:24:02 and 20:10:24:03. The Commission finds that GCC has met the legal requirements established for the granting of a certificate of authority. GCC has, in accordance with SDCL 49-31-3, demonstrated sufficient technical, financial and managerial capabilities to offer telecommunications services in South Dakota. The Commission approves GCC's application for a certificate of authority, subject to GCC furnishing the Commission with a corrected surety bond. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED, that GCC's application for a certificate of authority is hereby granted, subject to its filing a corrected surety bond with the Commission. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, that GCC shall file informational copies of tariff changes with the Commission as the changes occur.
