ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

TC96-149

ARSD 20:10:24:04, promulgated pursuant to SDCL §49-31-5 and §49-31-7.1(4), requires that any telecommunications company registered with the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) submit on May 1, of each year a report of certain specified financial and business information from the preceding calendar year.

Despite a reminder letter from the Commission on March 15, 1996, and a second reminder reflecting the possibility of a Show Cause Order on May 31, 1996, Caribbean Telephone and Telegraph d/b/a The Long Distance Company (CT&T) has failed to file such annual report as required by ARSD 20:10:24:04.

At its regularly scheduled July 9, 1996, meeting, the Commission considered whether to issue an Order to Show Cause as to why the Commission should not revoke CT&T's Certificate of Authority for failure to file an annual report. CT&T asked for an extension to July 24, 1996. The Commission voted to grant the requested extension. That extended deadline passed without the filing of the required report. The Commission was informed that CT&T filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection in United States Bankruptcy Court on April 5, 1996. On August 14, 1996, the Commission granted a continuance in this matter, until such time as the Commission determines that proceeding further will not interfere with the powers of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court.

On November 16, 2000, Commission Staff received word that the Bankruptcy Court had closed its file in this matter and the Commission would not receive any payment from the debtor.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-1, 49-1A, and 49-31, specifically, 49-1-11(4), 49-1A-3, 49-1A-4, 49-1A-5, 49-1A-6, 49-31-3, and ARSD 20:10:01:45.

On November 30, 2000, at a regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission considered this matter. Upon recommendation of Commission Staff, the Commission voted to close the docket. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above captioned matter shall be dismissed and the docket closed.
