On November 27, 2000, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation (Qwest) for approval of a negotiated resale agreement between Qwest and New Access Communications, LLC (New Access) pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 252(a)(1) and 252(e).

On November 30, 2000, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until December 18, 2000, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its duly noticed September 7, 2001, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the resale agreement between U S WEST and New Access. Commission Staff recommended not approving this agreement as a subsequent agreement between Qwest and New Access was filed with the Commission and that agreement has been approved.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-81, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Upon review of the agreement, the Commission found that pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2)(A), the implementation of this agreement would be inconsistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. It is therefore

ORDERED, that pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) and SDCL 49-31-81, the Commission does not approve the resale agreement which is the subject of this docket.
