On September 3, 2002, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed for approval by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an amendment to an interconnection agreement between lonex Communications North, Inc. (Ionex) and Qwest. The is made to utilize the Bill and Keep Compensation Mechanism as set forth in Attachment 1, attached to the Amendment.

On September 5, 2002, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until September 23, 2002, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its duly noticed October 17, 2002, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between Qwest and lonex. Commission Staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the negotiated amendment to the agreement as described herein.
