
On July 18, 2005, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a complaint filed by South Dakota Network, LLC (Complainant) against Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. (Global) regarding access charges. On July 21, 2005, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of August 5, 2005, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26, 49-1, including 49-1-9 and 49-1-11, 49-13, including 49-13-1 through 49-13-14.1, inclusive, and SDCL Chapter 49-31, including 49-31-3, 49-31-7, 49-31-7.1, 49-31-7.2, 49-31-11, 49-31-76 and 49-31-89, and ARSD Chapters 20:10:01 and 20:10:32.

On September 27, 2005, the Commission issued its Order Setting Procedural Schedule. On December 30, 2005, Complainant and Global filed a Joint Motion for Postponement of Procedural Schedule requesting that the outstanding events on the procedural schedule, including the hearing, be postponed until a scheduling stipulation can be reached or one of the parties moves the Commission to establish a procedural schedule. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the procedural schedule adopted by the Commission in its Order Setting Procedural Schedule of September 27, 2005, is cancelled.
