On June 28, 2006, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a petition from Western Telephone Company (Western) requesting the Commission grant an extension of the six month filing deadline for its 2006 intrastate switched access cost study.

On June 29, 2006, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 14, 2006, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 1-26-17.1, 49-1A-9, 49-31-12.6, 49-31-18, 49-31-19 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02, 20:10:01:15.05, 20:10:27:07 and 20:10:27:08.

On August 8, 2006, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission found good cause to grant the requested extension until December 31, 2006. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the requested extension is hereby granted, until December 31, 2006.
