ORDER APPROVING AGREEMENT

On July 19, 2006, PrairieWave Black Hills, LLC (PrairieWave) filed for approval by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a reciprocal transport and termination agreement between City of Brookings Municipal Telephone Department d/b/a Swiftel Communications (Swiftel) and PrairieWave.

On July 20, 2006, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until August 8, 2006, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its duly noticed August 23, 2006, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the agreement between PrairieWave and Swiftel. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the agreement.
