ORDER APPROVING
AGREEMENT

On October 10, 2006, the Commission received for approval a Reciprocal Interconnection, Transport and Termination Agreement between Armour Independent Telephone Company (Armour) and WWC License LLC (WWC).

On October 12, 2006, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until October 30, 2006, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its duly noticed October 31, 2006, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the agreement between Armour and WWC. Commission Staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement and the agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the agreement.
