On August 29, 2007, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (McLeodUSA) for approval of a revision to its South Dakota Access Tariff No. 3 to correct a typographical error. Due to a typographical error, the per access minute rate under 6.4 Local Transport – Tandem, (A) Tandem Switched Termination – per minute, reflected \$0.00237 in the previous Sheet No. 70 rather than \$0.000237, which is correctly reflected in the corrected Sheet No. 70. The effective date of the corrected sheet will remain June 19, 2007.

On August 30, 2007, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of September 14, 2007, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.
