REVISIONS TO ITS ACCESS SERVICE TARIFF)	TC08-138

On December 15, 2008, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation (Qwest) for approval of revisions to its Access Service Tariff. The filing introduces the Facility Signaling Point of Interconnection (FSPOI) to the Common Channel Signaling Network. FSPOIs are Qwest designated ordering points to which customers may establish SS7 signaling connections. No new rates or changes in rates are associated with FSPOI. Qwest is also clarifying language regarding CCSAC multiplexing to be consistent with provisioning processes. Qwest requested an effective date of January 27, 2009. On January 12, 2009, the Commission received replacement tariff pages from Qwest.

On December 18, 2008, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of January 2, 2009, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention.
