ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

TC11-007

On February 17, 2011, the Commission received a filing pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252 for approval of an Amendment to the Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and Long Lines Wireless, LLC. The amendment is made in order to add terms and conditions for Single Point of Presence (SPOP) in the LATA. The parties have agreed to implement the provision of the amendment upon execution or upon Commission approval.

On February 24, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until March 9, 2011, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its March 22, 2011, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the amendment to the agreement between Qwest Corporation and Long Lines Wireless, LLC. Commission Staff recommended approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the interconnection agreement.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that the amendment to the Type 2 Wireless Interconnection Agreement between Qwest and Long Lines Wireless, LLC is hereby granted.
