On September 9, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received for approval a filing of the Single Point of Presence in the LATA Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation and Broadvox-CLEC, LLC. The amendment shall be deemed effective upon approval by the Commission.

On September 15, 2011, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until September 29, 2011, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its October 11, 2011, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the amendment to the agreement between Qwest and Broadvox-CLEC, LLC. Commission staff recommended its approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest and Broadvox-CLEC, LLC.
