**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF
REVISIONS**

On February 2, 2012, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from MCC Telephony of the Midwest, LLC (MCC Telephony) for approval of revisions to its Intrastate Access Services Tariff No. 1. The purpose of this filing is to add provisions regarding the identification and rating of VoIP-PSTN traffic in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's Report and Order in WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161, add a service order charge, and make various textual changes to clarify existing provisions. MCC Telephony filed 1st Revised pages 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 23, 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 36, 38, 45, 50, 51, and 63. It also filed Original page 64.

On February 9, 2012, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of February 24, 2012, to interested individuals and entities. No parties sought intervention. On February 23, 2012, and February 29, 2012, MCC Telephony filed revised tariff pages.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of February 28, 2012, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the requested revisions to MCC Telephony's Intrastate Access Services Tariff No. 1. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the above referenced revisions to MCC Telephony's Intrastate Access Services Tariff No. 1 effective as of March 3, 2012.
