**ORDER GRANTING
INTERVENTION**

On May 23, 2014, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier from Blue Jay Wireless, LLC for the purpose of offering Lifeline services on a wireless basis throughout a majority of South Dakota, in both rural and non-rural areas.

On, May 29, 2014, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 13, 2014, to interested individuals and entities. On June 13, 2014, the South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) filed a Petition to Intervene.

At its June 24, 2014, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02, 20:10:01:15.03, and 20:10:01:15.05. Blue Jay stated it did not object to SDTA's intervention. Commission staff recommended that the Commission grant SDTA's Petition to Intervene. The Commission found that the Petition demonstrated good cause to grant intervention and voted unanimously to grant intervention to SDTA. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Petition to Intervene of SDTA is hereby granted.
