**ORDER APPROVING
AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT**

On August 14, 2015, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) for approval of an Amendment to the Resale Agreement between CenturyLink QC and InTTec, Inc. (InTTec), pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252.

On August 20, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of this filing to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until September 3, 2015, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on October 29, 2015, the Commission considered whether to approve the amendment to the resale agreement. Commission Staff recommended approval of the amendment to the resale agreement between InTTec and CenturyLink.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31, specifically 49-31-81, and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Upon review of the amendment, the Commission found that pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2)(A), the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the resale agreement between CenturyLink and InTTec.
