## ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

On October 2, 2015, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing for approval of a power reduction amendment to an interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC (CenturyLink) and CenturyLink Communications, LLC (CenturyLink Communications), for the State of South Dakota.

On October 8, 2015, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the amendment to interested individuals and entities. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the parties' request for approval had until October 22, 2015, to do so. No comments were filed.

At its October 29, 2015, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated amendment to the agreement between CenturyLink Communications and CenturyLink. Commission Staff recommended approval.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the amendment to the agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the amendment and the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the amendment to the agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission approves the amendment to the interconnection agreement between CenturyLink Communications and CenturyLink.
