**ORDER GRANTING
WITHDRAWAL OF
INTERVENTION**

On July 22, 2016, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an Application for Certificate of Authority to provide Local Exchange Services (Application) from eNetworks, LLC. In the Application, eNetworks, LLC seeks a certificate of authority in order to allow eNetworks, LLC to provide local exchange service in South Dakota. On August 29, 2016, eNetworks submitted revised pages 3 and 5 of the application, clarifying that the company seeks a certificate of authority in order to provide local exchange services in CenturyLink service territory only.

On July 28, 2016, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of August 12, 2016, to interested individuals and entities. On August 11, 2016, the South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) filed a Petition to Intervene. The intervention was granted by order dated September 6, 2016. On September 12, 2016, SDTA filed a letter requesting withdrawal of intervention.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05.

At its September 27, 2016, meeting, the Commission considered this matter. The Commission voted unanimously to grant the petition to withdraw the intervention. It is therefore

ORDERED, that SDTA's request for withdrawal of intervention is hereby granted.
